Clarification of News Report

We refer to the letter of the PSE, asking us to clarify or confirm today the quoted statements below in relation to the following news article entitled "Lufthansa Technik eyeing Bulacan, Cavite expansion" posted in BusinessWorld (Online Edition) on August 22, 2022, it was reported in part that:

"LUFTHANSA Technik Philippines, Inc. (LTP) is eyeing to expand outside the National Capital Region (NCR), with new airports to be built in Cavite and Bulacan as potential locations for its aircraft maintenance, repair and overhaul (MRO) services hubs, the company's chief executive officer said.

'In the Philippines, in Luzon, besides NAIA (Ninoy Aquino International Airport), [there is] currently only Clark,' LTP President and Chief Executive Officer Elmar Lutter told reporters on Friday on the sidelines of the formal opening of the company's new hangar in Pasay City.

'But you know, two more airport projects are being contemplated, Bulacan and Sangleys ports, and we are observing what is happening,' he added.

We confirm the above-quoted statements of Mr. Elmar Lutter, LTP's President and CEO, which were made on the sideline during the inauguration last Friday, August 19, 2022 of LTP's Hangar 1A, a multi-use hangar facility in the MacroAsia Special Economic Zone in Pasay City. LTP has occupied and developed almost all the available spaces in the ecozone where it is now located. Thus, this JV of MacroAsia Corporation and Lufthansa Technik AG of Germany is on the lookout for expansion projects in other airports within and outside the Philippines. Other than this broad goal, there are no other specific developments or detailed information that can be disclosed relevant to this matter at this time.
