- 2. Mr. Tan III was likewise appointed as member of the following committees vice Mr. Tan Jr.:

 - c) Investment Committee
 - d) Compensation Committee
- 3. Acceptance of the resignation of Mr. Rex Vincent Young as Director and member of the Audit Committee
- 4. In view of the resignation of Mr. Young as Director, Mr. Eduardo Luis T. Luy was elected as Director of the Corporation for the unexpired term of Mr. Young and until the election and qualification of his successor.

- 5. In view of the resignation of Mr. Young as member of the Audit Committee, Mr. Tan III was appointed as member of the Audit Committee.
- 6. Mr. Luy was elected as Treasurer of the Corporation for the unexpired term of Mr. Tan Jr..
- 7. Mr. Luy was likewise appointed as member of the Mining Committee vice Mr. Johnip G. Cua ("Mr. Cua").
- 8. Mr. Cua was appointed Chairman of the Mining Committee vice Mr. Tan Jr..
