Item 9. Others

MacroAsia Corporation (MAC) announced that its majority-owned subsidiary, MacroAsia Airport Services Corporation (MASCORP) has commenced the construction of a new six-story headquarters building, close to the Ninoy Aquino International Airport (NAIA), on a land that is owned by this subsidiary. The project, which held its formal groundbreaking today, January 16, 2026, is located along Sunrise Street, Barangay Tambo, Parañaque City, Metro Manila.

The planned headquarters will have an approximate gross floor area of over 8,600 square meters. It will house the administrative, operational, and executive offices of MacroAsia's aviation services business units and is also envisioned to serve as the shared services center for the MacroAsia Group. The project entails a total capital expenditure of ₱400 million, funded through bank financing with Security Bank.

Construction is expected to be completed by March 2027. Once operational, the facility will support MASCORP's workforce and operational requirements and will also offer office spaces available for third-party leasing.

About the Companies

MacroAsia Corporation (MAC) is a publicly listed company with a diversified portfolio in aviation support, logistics, catering, and natural resource development. Originally a mining company in the 1970s, it transitioned into a holding company as Cobertson Holdings Corporation before adopting its current name and structure in 1995.

MacroAsia Airport Services Corporation (MASCORP), established in 1997, is 80% owned by MAC and 20% by Konoike Transport Co., Ltd. As the Philippines' leading ground handling provider, it offers passenger services, ramp operations, baggage and cargo handling, GSE maintenance, and other terminal services, serving both local and international airlines across 22 airport stations nationwide.
