We are advising the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC), Philippine Stock Exchange (PSE), and the investing public that today, 29 April 2026, Tera Information and Connectivity Solutions, Inc. (TERA) - a wholly-owned subsidiary of MacroAsia Corporation - has received its Amended Articles of Incorporation (AOI). The Commission has officially approved the change of the subsidiary's corporate name and primary purpose to MacroAsia Shared Services Corp. (MSSC).

MSSC builds upon the services previously offered by TERA, which provided integrated information technology and connectivity solutions across the MacroAsia Group and its partner companies. The expanded scope now includes Finance, Human Resources, and Purchasing functions.

As a centralized shared service center, MSSC will consolidate enterprise support functions for MacroAsia business units to leverage the group's scale, reduce costs, enhance process efficiency, and promote transparency. Its mission is to enable MacroAsia's core business units to focus on value creation.

Initially offering high-volume transactional processing services, including vendor payments, customer billing and collection posting, general ledger recording and reporting, payroll and benefits administration, MSSC is expected to evolve into the Group's innovation platform, piloting digital tools and models aligned with MacroAsia's digital transformation.
